

Bilder vom Brunnenprojekt Gomonda, Maluza und Kandeu Malawi 2022

Hintergrund:

This project aims at providing for improved water, sanitation health service to people of three (3) communities namely Kandeu, Maluza and Gomonda in Ntcheu and Dedza districts, Malawi which fall under Ganya Parish, Dedza Diocese.

On one hand, Kandeu is more or less a trading centre with a primary school set up catering for a number of villages, hence the need for water to curb the spread of Coronavirus especially during market days for the villagers and daily for the school children.

On the other hand, Maluza and Gomonda villages are typical informal settlements in Dedza where the people, especially women and the girl child, have to travel distances to fetch water for household use.

In both cases, water scarcity becomes a big issue every dry season when the rivers dry up. Malawi is one of the countries in Africa affected by climate change and accelerated deforestation as people are dependent on firewood and charcoal for fuel.
